- LTRT Report

Completed SOG's on Type 2 TRT. Cache list is done. Work with existing Type 2 teams and develop ORE's with possible upgrading them to Type 1 LTRT's.

- Water Rescue Report

Position description document completed, typing document completed, cache will be reviewed and updated, and develop ORE. Documents to be presented to the Board for final review and acceptance by SERP and FFCA Board.

- DSFM Report

Operation Integration IV April 9-12. Formal invitations out next month. ORE self evaluations will be out end of Feb due back by May 31st. Wide Area Search April 24-26th at FSFC. Specialist classes to be organized through individual TF's to meet individual needs.

- DHS Report

2007 grant closed/no extension, 2008 grant expires Feb, 2009 expires April, 2010 expires 4-2013, 2012 grant will only be for training. Teams get training in to County TEP to aid in reimbursement from SHSGP funds.

3. SUSAR Report

SUSAR has restructured. At annual meeting in November, decided to give SUSAR one last opportunity to get rolling. Challenge the same for SUSAR as other systems which is funding, training, and typing.

4. FEMA National Program Report

Dean Scott was promoted in FEMA office to OSC. Contracted with company to do bottoms up review but did not get the results expected. Over arching review completed by Senior FEMA leadership and will be published in future. Re-writing many of the courses. Developed Haz Mat push packs housed strategically around the country to deploy to support operations after 1st 24 hours. Water rescue ad-

hoc worked on Water Operations in the Urban Search and Rescue Environment. Feds are not to same level of Florida. Working on phase 3 of evaluation process which will be a deployment activity. IST's will be using position task books for new members this year. Search group is working with gps group to develop a training program for GPS. EMAC issues discussed. Congress appropriated increased amount for the national USAR budget.
