TFL – all TF's to complete EMAC Request A form based on prescribed scenarios. Will then have cost factors for the different types of teams.

Training – Statute 633 passed and now includes verbiage for US&R and Haz Mat so allows for training level information to be put into Rule. Will include instructor levels and training facility requirements

DHS Funding Update

John Kohnke –2011 grant ends Mar 30 2014. Get claims in ASAP. 2012 grant end Feb 2014, no funding spent, get claims in as no more extensions allowed. Vigilant Guard claims need to be in ASAP.

State Urban Search and Rescue Alliance Report – Identifying and cataloging all state us&r assets and process for identifying credentials

National Urban Search and Rescue Program Office Report – TEEEx is on govt contract for US&R training revisions. Working on developing a continuing ed requirement per specialist and specialty. Each type 1 TF will go out with imbedded 14 person trained and equipped for flood/swiftwater. Haz Mat Equip push package provided to 7 TF's to be available for deployment for any TF. Search standardization for common reporting platform. Tunnel training discussed and currently awareness level however TF 1 and 2 have capabilities.
