- c) 3 teams in Region 4 that had funds withdrawn (Pinellas, New Port Richey, Polk County)
 - i) Not sure what will happen with unused funds-per John Kohnke they will go into a "pool" for now and state will decide how to allocate
- d) No funding for next year because not all the funds were used in time this year because of long delays in receiving equipment/vehicles, so state granted an extension. Hopeful we will receive funds the following year.

8) Water Deployment-TRTs deployable

a) State-From a deployment standpoint, the swift/floodwater teams are affiliated with the TFs. TRTs with water capabilities are a great local/regional resource but do not anticipate them getting deployed under a state mission assignment. Still need to track what teams have water assets for the state, so can be aware if needed for regional response.
