Community Lifeline Status


Ongoing medical supply limitations have the potential for leading to a destabilization of the health and medical lifeline.







Cummulative Resident Cases

Emergency Services	
ESF 4/9	Coordinating Fire-Rescue specific guidance for COVID-19. Identifying available SMEs for mission fulfillment.
ESF 8	Coordinating epidemiological investigations and contact tracing. March 29, 2020 10am DOH Coronavirus: summary of persons being monitored, persons under investigation, and cases. ESF 13	Supporting operations throughout the state including medical, security and logistical needs.
ESF 16	Coordinating with FLNG and airport police in support of EO-80. Providing awareness on continuity procedures to partners.

ESF 6	Working with partners to address anticipated needs and challenges including: Mental Health, Emotional, Spiritual Care, Feeding, and Vulnerable Populations. Supporting Feeding Florida's Operations.

SERT Chief Priorities for 3-29

1. Enhance data tracking in counties with over 100 cases. Create GIS layers by zip code to show cases, testing sites, and hospital surge information.
2. Continue to evaluate social distancing compliance in population centers over 100,000.
3. Reframe Surgeon General's priorities into "STEPS" acronym.
