Current Situation:

- PPE requests continue being made and are being filled as supplies arrive.
- FIRE DEPARMENTS NEED TO COORDINATE WITH THEIR COUNTY EM TO ENSURE THEIR PPE NEEDS ARE CLEARLY UNDERSTOOD
- Field Hospitals in Miami-Dade and Broward are now open.
- The number of cases is beginning to stabilize appearing to be plateauing with the need for ICU beds and ventilators remaining stable.
- Messaging for social distancing during Easter weekend
- 4 IMT's were activated yesterday to support ESF8 in their mission surrounding nursing homes and ALF's testing and monitoring.
- 10 additional testing sites Statewide are being finalized and will be in service by Monday.
- *On-going:* Working to determine effect of COVID-19 on the Fire Service personnel and departments.
- On-going: Florida's 5 STEPS to combating COVID-19
- *On-going*: USCG continues to monitor cruise ships off Florida's coasts.
- *On-going:* Continued evaluation of the need for additional field hospitals for surge capacities.
- *On-going:* Draft Wildfire Contingency Plan developed and is under review by FFS. Currently 39 active wildfires
- Severer weather risk for the Panhandle to Big Bend area for Sunday night into Monday morning.
- 19,347 COVID-19 cases; 452 deaths; 183,222 people tested seconded only to NY.
- Total SEOC Missions: 13,692
- FL Professional Firefighter COVID-19 cases*:
 - 63 Cases
 - 825 Out of Service**


