Current Situation:

- Continued focus on ensuring and supporting Miami-Dade with making emergency management plans operational to include medical surge plans.
- Surgeon General to coordinate faith-based conference call today or tomorrow to discuss mass gathering.
- Florida is currently seeing 13% positive results in tests performed.
- There is **NO** PPE available. What is received by the State is immediately sent out.
- Continue to practice social distancing and protect the elderly
- Non-Congregate Sheltering guidance sent to FFCA for posting.
- DEM legal staff's position regarding interpretations of Executive Orders is that it should be directed to each jurisdiction's legal counsel
- *On-going:* Continued monitoring of cruise ship and Port Everglades.
- *On-going:* ESF-8 working on hospital surge plan to determine need for field hospital(s)
- *On-going:* Waiting on guidance from Surgeon General on first responder passive exposure
- *On-going:* Wildfire contingency plan still being developed
- Currently 52 active wildfires.
- 8,010 COVID-19 cases; 128 deaths; 69,265 tested in Florida
- Current number of SEOC Missions: 10,415

Important takeaways for this document:

- **Focus on Miami-Dade County.**
- **Surgeon General discussing mass gatherings with faith-based organizations**
- **NO PPE available**
- **Cases will continue to increase**
- **Maintain a sense of urgency on all aspects of this crisis**

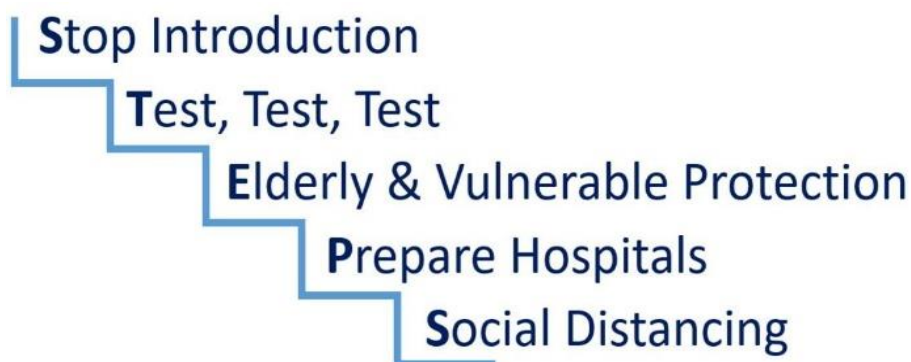
