Current Situation:

- PPE continues to be an issue; logistic requests for PPE should be realistic and not exceed a 10 day burn rate.
 Strategies should be developed to reduce the burn rate of PPE until the cache of PPE can catch up. Use the standard Requisition Request Form #0067 in WebEoc the form created on 4/18/20 has been deleted. BE REALISTIC in your requests.
- FIRE DEPARMENTS NEED TO COORDINATE WITH THEIR COUNTY EM TO ENSURE THEIR PPE NEEDS ARE CLEARLY UNDERSTOOD
- State IMT's to support field hospitals, ACHA to add a 1-member team for regulatory guidance.
- Positive cases and the need for ICU/Ventilators remain stable with some reduction.
- Continued focus on long term care facilities with REST and IMT's.
 These facilities have seen a spike in cases with 1849 positive cases.
- Focus on homeless shelters, home base nursing and preventative measures.
- On-going: Working to determine effect of COVID-19 on the Fire Service personnel and departments.
- On-going: Florida's 5 STEPS to combating COVID-19
- On-going: USCG continues to monitor cruise ships off Florida's coasts.
- On-going: Continued efforts for increasing lab capabilities new lab to open in Alachua County.

 On-going: Draft Wildfire Contingency Plan developed and is under review by FFS. Currently 20 active wildfires

- Monitoring weather. Storm damage reported in West FL today
- Monitoring CDC efforts in validation of rapid and antibody testing.
- 26,660 COVID-19 cases; 806 deaths; 267,000 people tested, >50% of the positive cases are in SE FL.
- Total SEOC Missions: 15,256

Important takeaways for this document:

- PPE arriving is being deployed coordinate with County EM to ensure your realistic PPE needs are clearly understood
- Social Distancing and 5-STEPS continues to be pushed out
- Wildfire Contingency Plan draft is under review


