## **Current Situation:**

- SFM will be coordinating with fire departments on fire inspections of Alternate Care Sites/Field Hospitals
- FDOH developing for the general public, a message on the proper mask in use when out in public
- First Alternate Care Site is the Miami Convention Center. Construction starts today.
- First Responder passive exposure FDOH recommends to use CDC Interim U.S. Guidance for Risk Assessment and Public Health Management of Healthcare Personnel with Potential Exposure in a Healthcare Setting to Patients with Coronavirus Disease (COVID-19)
- On-going: Working to determine effect of COVID-19 on the Fire Service personnel and departments.
- On-going: Very limited PPE available.
- On-going: USCG continues to monitor cruise ships off Florida's coasts.
- On-going: Continued deployment of two field hospitals and evaluation of deployment of third, which all will be hospital (non-ICU) level.
- On-going: Wildfire contingency plan still being developed
- Currently 43 active wildfires
- 14,504 COVID-19 cases; 283 deaths; 138,618 tested
- Total SEOC Missions: 12,164
- FL Professional Firefighter COVID-19 cases\*:
  - 51 Cases
  - 584 Out of Service


