Signed **April 1** and Effective April 3 – 30th

Senior citizens and individuals with underlying medical conditions shall stay at home and take all measures to limit exposure to COVID-19.

All persons in Florida shall limit their movements and personal interactions outside of their home to only those necessary to obtain or provide essential services or conduct essential activities.







Cumulative Resident Cases

SERT Chief Priorities

1. Enhance data tracking in counties with over 100 cases. Create GIS layers by zip code to show cases, testing sites, and hospital surge information.
2. Continue to evaluate social distancing compliance in population centers over 100,000.
3. Ensure that communities over 100,000 have medical surge plans in place and are prepared to implement them.
4. ESFs distribute guidance for their specific industries.
5. Implement further social distancing initiatives within the SEOC.
