SEOC at Level 1 09:00 – 17:00

- Florida's 5 STEPS to combating COVID 19
 - **S**top the introduction of COVID 19
 - **T**est, test, test
 - **E**lderly and vulnerable protection
 - **P**repare the hospitals
 - **S**ocial Distancing

- Current COVID-19 State obligated expenditures at \$709M
- Positive test percentage declining
- Demand for ICU beds less than 400
- 357k tests performed (1 out of every 60 residents have been tested)
- 31,300 positive COVID 19 cases in Florida
- 1,076 deaths related to COVID 19 in Florida
- Fire Service Numbers
 - Workforce Out – 564
 - Workforce positive - 123
- Focus remains on testing with specific focus on rural testing. Plans for specific rural strategy expected out today or tomorrow.
- ~~N95 mask should not be thrown away~~ as the decontamination system for N-95 masks will be operational on Thursday at Miami-Dade Hard Rock Stadium. A webinar is scheduled for today at 2pm for EM, FR, and LE as related to general information and registration. 2-3 pm EST
