- Florida's 5 STEPS to combating COVID 19
 - **S**top the introduction of COVID 19
 - **T**est, test, test
 - **E**lderly and vulnerable protection
 - **P**repare the hospitals
 - **S**ocial Distancing
- COVID-19 Activation day 77
- Currently 48,160 positive cases of COVID-19 in Florida with 2,188 deaths reported.
- Of concern commercial flights have resumed, uptick of 40 flights into Florida yesterday with 2,000 travelers
- Partnership with Children's Hospitals UC for pediatric virus cases
- The number of cases in Brazil and travel are of concern
- Purchase orders have been reduced to \$555M
- CVS has established 37 sites for testing in partnership with Quest Labs
- Publix and Home Depot are making parking lots available as drive-thru testing sites.
- Continue testing in the foreseeable future.
- It is predicted that the State will be experiencing thunderstorms across the state today with average of 1" or less rainfall in most locations.
- Weekend staffing will be 9-5, Memorial Day Monday support ESFs on call.
- Active fires (statewide): 76 for 14,329 acres
- National Hurricane Center updated season predefinitions: 13 named storms, 6-10 Hurricanes and 3-6 major
- Florida Fire Service Impact – out of 35,055 employees reported, 339 out of work, 168 employees testing positive
