- Florida's 5 STEPS to combating COVID 19
 - **S**top the introduction of COVID 19
 - **T**est, test, test
 - **E**lderly and vulnerable protection
 - **P**repare the hospitals
 - **S**ocial Distancing
- It is officially Hurricane Season
- Monitoring disturbance in southwestern Gulf area. This disturbance has an 80% chance of development at this time with the potential to develop and move North. Regardless of the development level it is anticipated Florida will experience higher rain chances this weekend.
- 533m obligated expenditures toward COVID 19
- Continued effort to identify options for relocation of community based testing sites to a more weather resistance environment.
- Enhanced focus on field worker safety as summer heat arrives
- Many of the testing sites will be closed today and tomorrow due to staffing impacts.
- Exploring options for expansion of walk up testing within storefront partners
- Finalizing catalog of elder care services.
- Florida has performed over 1 million COVID 19 tests
- Florida Fire Service Impact – 338 employees out of work, 170 employees testing positive
