SEOC Level 1 08:00 – 18:00

- Florida's 5 STEPS to combating COVID 19
 - **S**top the introduction of COVID 19
 - **T**est, test, test
 - **E**lderly and vulnerable protection
 - **P**repare the hospitals
 - **S**ocial Distancing
- Monitoring Tropical Depression 3 in southwestern Gulf area. This disturbance has an 80% chance of development with the potential and move North. Regardless of the development level it is anticipated Florida receive 4-6 inches of rain statewide over the next 4 to 5 days.
- \$537M obligated expenditures toward COVID 19
- Continued effort to identify options for relocation of community-based testing sites to a more weather resistance environment. All State testing sites are operating today, some taking precautions due to civil unrest.
- Preparing for mass distribution of cloth masks from the Feds
- ESF 16 reports calm communities last night from civil unrest, curfews lifting in many areas. Will ramp up LE presence for the weekend.
- Publix opening 3 testing sites in South Florida.
- All Florida National Guard assets for local law enforcement support have been demobilized to standby.
- Discussion of State payment system shut down last 2 weeks of June for year-end reconciliation. All anticipated needs to be procured now.
- To date Florida has tested 1,041,318 persons, 56,830 positive cases and 2,460 deaths reported.
- Florida Fire Service COVID-19 Impact – 331 employees out of work, 170 employees testing positive
