SEOC Level 1 08:00 – 18:00

- Florida's 5 STEPS to combating COVID 19
  - **S**top the introduction of COVID 19
  - **T**est, test, test
  - **E**lderly and vulnerable protection
  - **P**repare the hospitals
  - **S**ocial Distancing
- 64 Counties in Florida to enter Phase 2 of Re-Opening tomorrow.
- Monitoring Tropical Storm Cristobal in southwestern Gulf area. Current concern surrounds potential of 7 to 10 inches of rain between Saturday evening and Monday and possibly beyond creating the potential for flooding.
- Current flood watch for Florida south of I-4
- Evaluating potential secondary threat of river flooding, post landfall due to substantial rainfall amounts north of Florida.
- Preparing mitigation effort for community-based testing sites as related to potential flooding issues.
- DEM Legal preparing executive order for potential need as related to flooding issues
- SEOC Planning preparing IAP for TS Cristobal potential impacts
- Monitoring peaceful protest and civil unrest for impacts to, information sharing and mutual aid request.
- Curfews in some areas of the State are being lifted
- Monitoring to continue through June 9<sup>th</sup> currently
- 555m obligated expenditures toward COVID 19
- Developing reasonable visitation plan for long term care facilities.
- Antibody testing has been expanded to the public at the community based testing sites previously conducting them for first responders.
- Florida Fire Service Impact – 294 employees out of work, 173 employees testing positive
