SEOC Level 1 08:00 – 18:00

- Florida's 5 STEPS to combating COVID 19
  - **S**top the introduction of COVID 19
  - **T**est, test, test
  - **E**lderly and vulnerable protection
  - **P**repare the hospitals
  - **S**ocial Distancing
- Evaluating potential secondary threat of river flooding, post TS Cristobal landfall due to the substantial rainfall received and amounts projected north of Florida.
- Evaluating damages to community-based testing sites resulting from TS Cristobal and making necessary repairs to reopen site.
- Flood watch remains in Pensacola area
- Heat index of 100+ over the next few days
- Monitoring peaceful protest and civil unrest for impacts, information sharing and mutual aid request.
- Information of planned events through the end of June. Specific focus surrounding the planned funeral scheduled for Tuesday.
- Information of unplanned groups blocking random roads; not just downtown areas
- 700m obligated expenditures toward COVID 19
- Finalizing visitation plan for long term care facilities.
- Monitoring case increase in Lee, Palm Beach and Hillsborough counties as well as church in Desoto County.
- 63,385 cases; 2,707 deaths; 1,236,000 tests performed; 4.0% current positivity rate. Approximately 10k cases and 1400 deaths in long term care facilities.
- Beginning planning for potential of RNC being moved to Florida.
- Gathering information on planned community July 4<sup>th</sup> events.
- Conducting regional meeting surrounding hurricane planning.
- Florida Fire Service Impact – 309 employees out of work, 179 employees testing positive
