SEOC Level 1 07:00 – 19:00

- Florida's 5 STEPS to combating COVID 19
 - **S**top the introduction of COVID 19
 - **T**est, test, test
 - **E**lderly and vulnerable protection
 - **P**repare the hospitals
 - **S**ocial Distancing
- Hurricane has been forecasted to increase off the coast of Florida
- Current storm surge for SE Florida if forecasted to be 1-3 feet
- Forecasting of storm surge for NE Florida is ongoing and should be available later today and track becomes more defined.
- Rain totals are forecasted to be in the 3-5 inch range along the coast with less inland.
- Region 7 Counties should begin to feel impact tonight.
- Executive Order 20-181 issued by Governor.
- Activation of WEBEOC event has occurred
- SEOC has authorized the opening of one (1) non- congregate shelter, location to be determined
- Planning assumption include power outages and downed trees
- With beach erosion being one of the bigger concerns, Flagler County is being monitored closely.
