



COVID-19 Situation

The positivity rate for Florida residents over the last 14 days has averaged **9.32%** among the **1,676,007** persons tested. The current median age among cases is 40 years. There are currently **4,614** COVID+ patients hospitalized, with **1,019** in ICU.


