



COVID-19 Situation

The positivity rate for Florida residents over the last 14 days has averaged **10.06%** among the **1,872,707** persons tested. The current median age among cases is 40 years. There are currently **5,193** COVID+ patients hospitalized, with **1,026** in ICU.

Vaccine Distribution


Today, **51,675** Pfizer Vaccines were delivered throughout Florida. There are currently **70,200** additional dosages of the Pfizer vaccine in transit to hospitals in Broward, Duval, Hillsborough, Orange, and Miami-Dade expected to be delivered tomorrow.
