



COVID-19 Situation

The positivity rate for Florida residents over the last 14 days has averaged **10.19%** among the **1,861,147** persons tested. The current median age among cases is 40 years. There are currently **5,451** COVID+ patients hospitalized, with **1,021** in ICU.

Yesterday, **70,200** Pfizer Vaccines were delivered to hospitals in Broward, Duval, Hillsborough, Orange, and Miami-Dade.


In total, **118,950** Pfizer vaccines have been delivered to hospitals in Florida.
