



COVID-19 Situation

The positivity rate for Florida residents over the last 14 days has averaged **12.04%** among the **1,877,295** persons tested. The current median age among cases is 40 years. There are currently **6,746** COVID+ patients hospitalized, with **1,358** in ICU.


