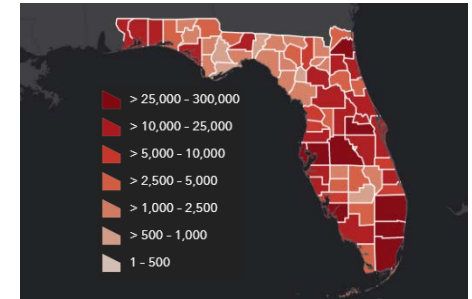

## Summary of Cases

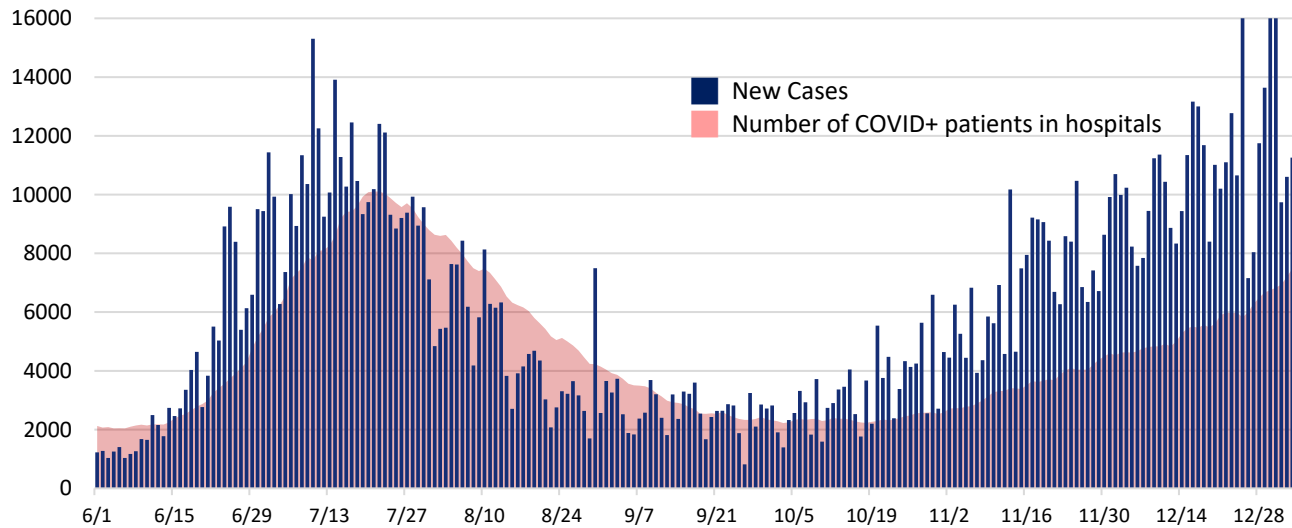

## COVID-19 Situation

The positivity rate for Florida residents over the last 14 days has averaged **13.13%** among the **1,821,526** persons tested. The current median age among cases is 40 years. There are currently **7,775** COVID+ patients hospitalized, with **1,422** in ICU.

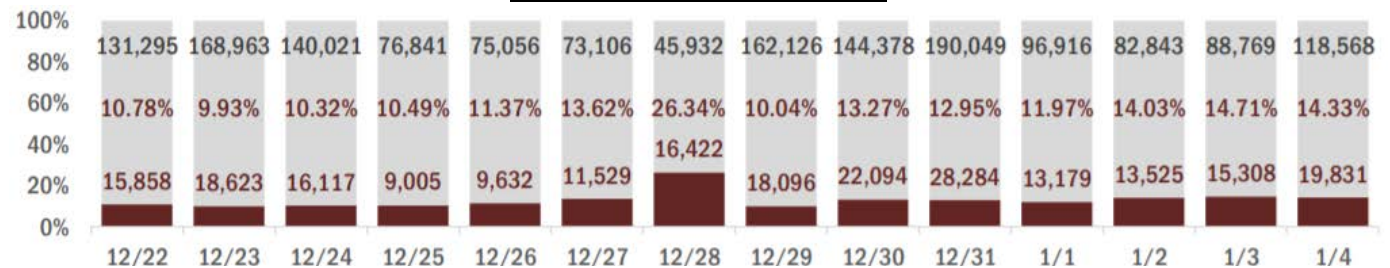
