



COVID-19 Situation

The positivity rate for Florida residents over the last 14 days has averaged **13.62%** among the **1,838,813** persons tested. The current median age among cases is 40 years. There are currently **7,804** COVID+ patients hospitalized, with **1,447** in ICU.


