



COVID-19 Situation

The positivity rate for Florida residents over the last 14 days has averaged **13.82%** among the **1,876,408** persons tested. The current median age among cases is 40 years. There are currently **7,858** COVID+ patients hospitalized, with **1,496** in ICU.


