On February 16, 2021, Scott A. Rivkees, MD, State Surgeon General, Florida Department of Health issued an Emergency Rule 64JER21-1, Paramedic and Emergency Medical Technician Administration of COVID-19 Vaccines (Attachment 1).

This Emergency Rule (ER) authorizes licensed EMS agencies to conduct in-house trainings and psychomotor skills validations by following the training outlined below:
