- Special Event Cancellations are being tracked in Info Message 37.

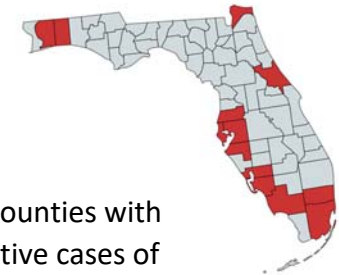
