

COVID19 SEOC Briefing  
03/29/2020

SEOC at Level 1 07:00-19:00

- 4,242 COVID-19 cases in Florida with 56 deaths
- Modeling continues to be evaluated and changes with current modeling indicating peak to occur in Florida early/mid May.
- Greater data evaluation of Counties with 100 or greater cases will be evaluated by Zip Code with several overlays to include testing sites and hospital data.
- Florida's 5 STEPS to combating COVID 19
  - **S**top the introduction of COVID 19
  - **T**est, test, test
  - **E**lderly and vulnerable protection
  - **P**repare the hospitals
  - **S**ocial Distancing
- ESF-16 to continue evaluation and monitoring of population centers over 100,000 - are they showing compliance with Governor's orders i.e. groups 10 and under, bar restaurant closure and local curfews?
- \$398 million obligated to date
- Evaluating Florida's comparability to the COVID 19 Washington Model

- Monitoring of severe weather potential for Tuesday with the passage of a front, potential for 60 mph winds, heavy rains and lightning.
- Collection/Testing Site
  - Orange – 250 collections
  - Duval – 282 collections
  - Miami/Dade – 250(Federal), 253(State) collections
  - Marlin – 178 collections
  - Broward – 533 collections
- Approximately 1,750 inbound airline passengers screened
