SEOC at Level 1 07:00-19:00

- 5,048 COVID-19 cases in Florida with 62 deaths with 50k test performed. 50% of the cases are in Broward and Dade Counties.
- Work on verification of communities >100k that they have their surge plans in place.
- Work on decompressing the human footprint in the SEOC. Option being evaluated of offsite work with limited staffing at the SEOC.
- Focus on verifying that the low-income housing population and other housing with higher density ratios are being evaluated and addressed as related to social distancing and virus spread preventive measures.
- Finalizing of essential and non-essential business definitions for potential future isolation measures.
- Testing of dial-in capability for SEOC briefings today with planned go-live tomorrow.
- Data to Surgeon General on NH/ALF surveillance effort and testing results.
- Currently 74 active wildfires in the State
- Northerly shift of severe weather forecast related in approaching cold front.
- Florida's 5 STEPS to combating COVID 19
 - Stop the introduction of COVID 19
 - o **T**est, test, test
 - <u>E</u>Iderly and vulnerable protection
 - Prepare the hospitals
